Eagle Fire Department Update – Chief Jamie Vincent

SCBA Pricing: Chief Vincent reported that he and Chief Carbone (BFD) have been working together to obtain the lowest pricing possible for the SCBA packs. The new packs have a lead time of about 3 months before delivery and an additional month for training before they are put into service.

Station 5: Everything is going well at Station 5. The firefighters are very happy there and have a good rapport with the community.

New Engine E-5: The print approval trip to Wisconsin has been pushed back to mid or end of July.

Flood Control: Boise River water flow is staying between 5500 and 6500. Thirty-nine percent of reservoir system capacity is still available. The long-term weather forecast is favorable at this time.
