Boise Fire Department Report – Assistant Chief Romeo Gervais

Fire Station 13 is to open June 16. The Engine 13 crew will be moving into Station 18 approximately May 5 and will remain at Station 18 until Station 13 is move-in ready.

Eagle Fire Department Report – Deputy Chief Jamie Vincent & Division Chief Sean MarvinChief Vincent introduced Div. Chief of Logistics, Sean Marvin, to the NACFR Board. Chief Vincent's last day before retirement will be April 30, 2025.

- Station 5 Call Volume Statistics: Chief Vincent discussed the Station 5 call volume report which the Board received earlier in the week. EFD will provide call volume statistics to the NACFR Board on a quarterly basis going forward.
- Station 5 Generator Installation: The alternator for the Station 5 generator caught fire on start up. A new alternator will be delivered March 26.
- Station 5 HVAC System: The Station 5 HVAC system is being evaluated due to a lack of air flow on the second floor.
- Station 5 Firefighter Office: The Firefighter Office has been completed. Computer work stations are now available for each firefighter on duty to accomplish training and work day tasks.
- Station 5 Landscape Contract: The landscaping contract for Station 5 has been cancelled. The Hidden Springs landscaping company seems to be mowing and trimming the spaces surrounding Station 5.
