BUSINESS

*Motion to Approve Resolution #85 – A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the North Ada County Fire & Rescue District; Repealing Resolution #79; and, Preparing, Approving and Adopting the Budget for the payment of the current expenses of the North Ada County Fire & Rescue District for the Fiscal Year beginning on the 1st day of October, 2025, and ending on the 30th day of September, 2026, and directing the District Secretary.

The Board of Commissioners approved the FY 2026 Budget Resolution No. 79 following the public hearing on the budget, but that resolution errantly used the maximum levy authority referenced in the final L-2 worksheet (Dollar Certification Form); and It is therefore necessary, and in the best interests of the District and its property tax payers, that the Board repeal Resolution No. 79 and that this resolution be approved which reflects the maximum levy authority references in the preliminary L-2 worksheet (Dollar Certification Form); and

The Commissioners have determined that it is in the best interests of the residents and property lying within the Fire District and necessary to provide the level of service required for the preservation of life and property within the Fire District that the following FY 2026 Budget be adopted. In compliance with the requirements of I.C. § 31-1422, the North Ada County Fire & Rescue District does hereby adopt as its FY 2026 Budget for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of October, 2025 and ending on the 30th day of September, 2026.
