North Ada County Fire & Rescue District Board of Commissioners did conduct a regular Commissioner Meeting at 4:00 p.m., Monday, April 13, 2026. The meeting was available in person and via teleconference**.

Call To Order: 4:02 p.m.

Commissioner Roll Call: Commissioners Souza and Bunderson were present at 4:00 p.m. Commissioner Ramey joined the meeting at 4:08 p.m.

BUSINESS

***Consideration to Approve Minutes dated March 9, 2026.**

Commissioner Bunderson made motion to approve the minutes dated March 9, 2026. Commissioner Souza second. No discussion. Roll Call Vote: Bunderson (yes), Souza (yes). Motion carried.

***Consideration to Approve the Check List dated April 13, 2026.**

DA Vaughan noted that the check list contains 3rd quarter payments to Boise Fire Department, Eagle Fire Department and the Ada County Sheriff's Office for Dispatch services. Eagle Fire Department Update – Asst. Chief Theron Hudson

Chief Hudson provided call volume data for the Board to review. In addition, he reported that the awnings at Station 5 were recently re-stained.

Boise Fire Department Update – Asst. Chief Romeo Gervais

Call Volume Data: Call volume data was provided for the NACFR Board to review.

Engine 16 wreck: Chief Gervais reported that Engine 16 recently scraped the entire passenger side of the engine on the engine bay door opening due to cutting the corner too closely. Logistics Chief Kircher is investigating and is in touch with DA Vaughan regarding the issue. The engine is at City Shops for repairs and paint.

Fireworks Ban: Chief Gervais began a discussion about fireworks bans. Chief Hudson from Eagle Fire and the NACFR Board discussed issues including Authority Having Jurisdiction, County Law and Fireworks Bans, Maps and Enforcement. Chief Gervais recommended pausing further discussion and action for this year. He and Chief Lewis of EFD will continue conversations regarding best practices and will include Bill Gigray, attorney for the Districts, in those discussions. The NACFR Board agreed with this proposed path forward.
